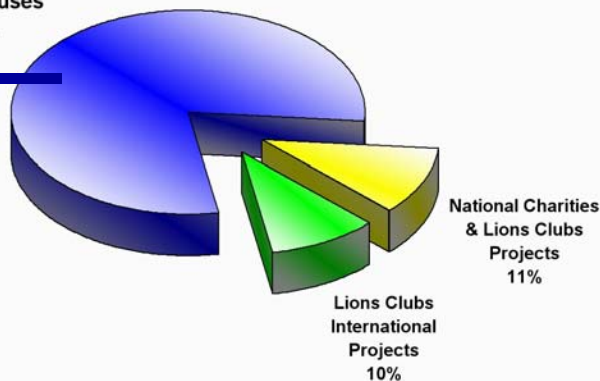

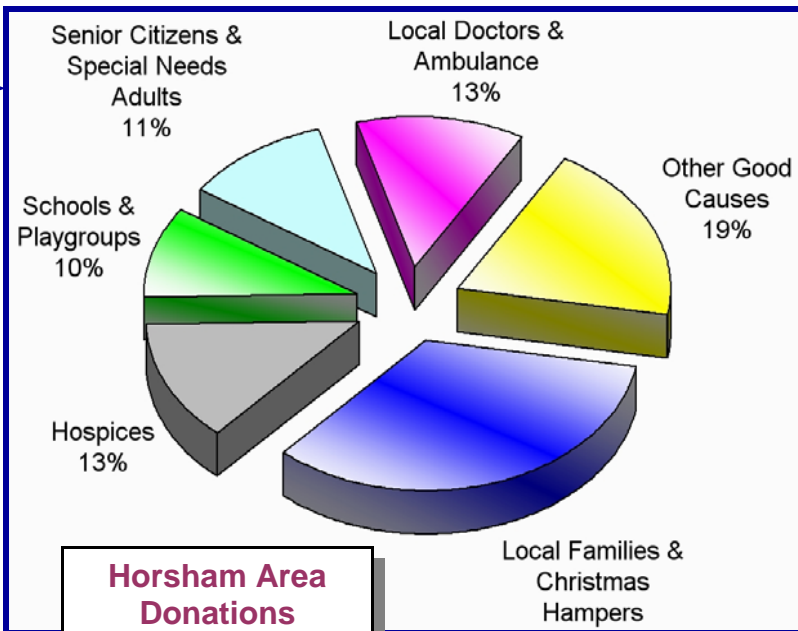

Horsham Lions Club is part of Lions Clubs International, the largest service organisation in the world.

Every member of Horsham Lions Club pays an annual subscription that is used towards the running and administration of the Club.

Horsham Lions Club does not use any monies from fundraising for administration, only genuine costs incurred are deducted. These costs include materials and equipment without which the raising of funds for charitable purposes would not be possible.

Horsham Lions Club Charitable Trust Fund is a registered charity (no. 1059270) and submits a statutory annual return to The Charity Commission.

Every application for donation or grant is carefully considered by the Horsham Lions Club Services Committee and presented to all members at a monthly meeting. Every donation is determined by majority vote of the members.
